



Expectations For Volunteers

- **Hours:** Students are expected to keep track of his or her own dates and hours throughout their time at Pediatric Rehab. It is important to communicate with your supervisor about signing off on the hours.
- **Attendance:** Students are expected to meet their commitments to their schedule. Supervisor must be notified of any absences in advance or as soon as possible.
- **Project and Goals:** Students are expected to work on their semester project and goals during slow periods of the day. Ask supervisor questions that pertain to improving the project and completing the goals.
- **Dress Appropriately:** Students are expected to follow the dress code. Proper attire will allow for students to participate in activities throughout the day.
- **Reliability:** Students are expected to be punctual for volunteer shifts. Ask for any reviews or evaluations of yourself to improve your performance.
- **Willingness:** Be willing to learn and participate in daily activities by setting up, cleaning up or interacting with patients. Ask questions to expand your knowledge and gain valuable skills.
